Summer Is Here...Now What?

For most people, when summer comes, that means increased entertainment and leisurely activities, such as watersports, golf, camping, cooking out, traveling, etc. These are fun times with family and friends. When vacation times are at their highest, which for many people is in the summer, this easily becomes the occasion to take a vacation from the word of God, from being fed, strengthened, and preserved in the one true Christian faith. None of the activities mentioned are in and of themselves sin. We usually think of sin only in terms of things that are inherently evil versus things that are inherently good.

We usually think of idolatry as the worship of inherently evil things. In the 1st commandment God forbids us to have other gods instead of Him or beside Him (idolatry). Idolatry is: 1) Regarding and/or worshipping any creature as God; 2) Believing in a god who is not the Triune God; and 3) Fearing, loving, or trusting in any person or thing as they should fear, love, and trust in God alone.

It is this third kind of idolatry that is most dangerous and pervasive in our day. *For you may be sure of this, that everyone who is sexually immoral or impure, or who is covetous, (that is, an idolater), has no inheritance in the kingdom of Christ and God (Ephesians 5:5).* Fearing, loving, or trusting any act of sex, which is a good gift of God in the context of the marriage of one man and woman only, is still idolatry. Being covetous (wanting something or someone that God has given to someone else and not to you) is idolatry and deserving of eternal punishment.

This summer, as at other times of the year, the temptation will be to forsake the divine service for entertainment, leisure, and fun. Christians can still enjoy the good gifts of God given in travel, watersports, camping, and the like, without needing to turn them into gods that are served and worshiped, rather than the One true God on Sunday mornings. As baptized and regenerated creatures, (Titus 3:5-7), we are called to put off the things of our old life and self and put on the new self (Colossians 3:9-10). We can keep the first three commandments of God by coming first to the divine service, and then enjoy these other good gifts. Christ has set us free, not to continue in sin that grace may abound, but free from sin and alive to God (Romans 6:1-11).

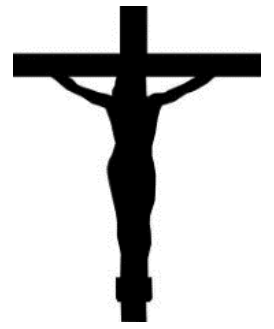
